TOUR PROGRAM

5, THURSDAY DEPARTURE FROM HOUSTON
A departure from Houston is planned. We're on our way to Amsterdam where our musical adventure will begin!

6, FRIDAY THE NETHERLANDS - AMSTERDAM, ALPHEN A.D RIJN

Good morning! We've just landed in Amsterdam. After collecting our luggage, proceed via customs into the Arrival Hall. Here we'll meet our tour manager. After loading luggage and instruments, we're off for a visit to one of the picturesque coastal villages near Amsterdam. Late this afternoon, drive to the nearby town of Alphen a.d. Rijn where a two-night stay is planned. This evening's dinner is at the hotel. (D)

7, SATURDAY AMSTERDAM, DELFT, ALPHEN A.D. RIJN

After breakfast, we're off to Amsterdam. We'll start our sightseeing with a boat cruise through the many picturesque canals in Amsterdam.

Then visit the Rijksmuseum, Holland's State Treasure House with masterpieces by such well-known artists as Rembrandt and Vermeer. Following an independent lunch we will travel to Delft, a medieval city of canals and cobbled alleyways. A visit will be made to "De Porceleyne Fles," the factory where authentic Delftware is made according to ancient methods. In the late afternoon, we will return to the hotel for an early dinner followed by a rehearsal and concert performance in Leiden. (B, D)



8, SUNDAY MARGRATEN, MAASTRICHT, HEERLEN

Travel to Margraten where we will visit the Netherlands American Cemetery, the only American Military Cemetery in the Netherlands. Most of these Americans gave their lives in defense of our freedom during Operation Market Garden (September 1944) and the Battle of the Bulge (December 1944). Continue on to Maastricht, a town whose history dates back to Roman times. Located on the banks of the great Maas River, Maastricht is nearly at the point where the Dutch, German, and Belgian borders meet. After an independent lunch and guided walking tour of the city, there will be free time to explore the pedestrian precincts before we check into our hotel in Heerlen. Dinner is planned at the hotel. An afternoon or evening concert is planned in one of the towns in this area, possibly as a joint concert with a local band. (B, D)

9, MONDAY GERMANY - COLOGNE, BONN, RHINE CRUISE, LADENBURG

Travel into Germany where our first stop will be in Cologne, capital of the German Rhineland. World War II

bombing raids destroyed most of this historic city. The cathedral with its famous twin spires, dating back to 1164, survived the bombing raids. After some time to admire this huge edifice, we continue to Bonn for lunch and a visit to the home where Beethoven was born. Next it's on to Boppard to board a Rhine steamer for a cruise on the loveliest section of the Rhine River. Disembark in St. Goar, a picturesque and popular Rhine town. Back on the bus, continue to the town of Ladenburg, our home for the next two nights. Dinner is planned at the hotel. (B, D)



10, TUESDAY HEIDELBERG, LADENBURG

This morning we'll transfer into Heidelberg, the university city nestled in its romantic setting in the Neckar Valley. Our guided sightseeing tour includes a visit to Heidelberg Castle, the 12th-century Witch Tower, and Hercules' Fountain in the Marketplace. A late morning concert is planned in the Marktplatz. Following the concert, we'll have time for independent lunch. The balance of the afternoon is free for shopping and more sightseeing. This evening we'll reboard the bus and return to Ladenburg. (B)

11, WEDNESDAY ROTHENBURG OB DER TAUBER

Travel via the autobahn to Rothenburg ob der Tauber, where the old houses, fountains, and street signs plunge you back into the atmosphere of the 16th century. After our sightseeing tour, you might also enjoy a survey of the city from atop the sentry walk, which runs along the city ramparts. For a magnificent view of the medieval walled city, climb to the top of the 120-foot Gothic Rathaus Tower. Sometime this afternoon, our band will give an outdoor concert in the Market Square. A one-night stay is planned in this wonderful town with plenty of time for shopping and independent dinner. In the evening, we'll gather in the Market Square to join the night watchman as he makes his rounds through this charming and picturesque town. (B)



12, THURSDAY DINKELSBÜHL, AUGSBURG, ERDING

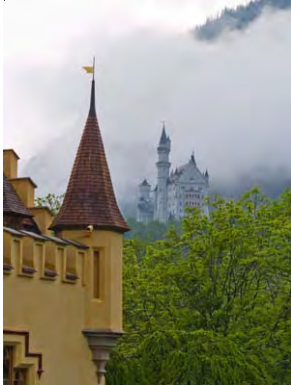
After breakfast, travel along the Romantic Road to Dinkelsbühl. After a stop in this delightful town, continue southward to Augsburg. We plan to spend a couple of hours in Augsburg, a city that is a reminder of life in the

Renaissance period. We will take some time to visit the Basilica of St. Ulrich and St. Afra, once the church of a Benedictine monastery. A visit will also be made to the Fuggerei, an area of eight medieval streets with gabled houses. Our next and last stop of the day is in Erding, the town that will be our home for the last three nights of our tour. After hotel check-in, an evening concert performance is planned. Afterwards there will be plenty of time for your independent dinner. (B)

13, FRIDAY

NEUSCHWANSTEIN, WIES,
MUNICH, ERDING

Today we'll travel south to Neuschwanstein Castle, one of the fairytale castles built by King Ludwig. It was this castle that served as the inspiration for Disneyland's castle. After a tour of the castle, drive to the small village of Wies and visit the beautiful little rococo style church, called Wieskirche. After time for a late lunch, continue to Munich, the Bavarian capital. Here visit the Michaelskirche to see the royal crypt. Thirty of the Wittelsbach princes, including Ludwig II of Bavaria, are buried here. Afterwards we'll take time to explore the



Marienplatz, the crossroads where the life of the town is concentrated. If we time it right, there may be an opportunity to see the playing of the Glockenspiel. After time for independent dinner, reboard the motorcoach and travel back to our hotel in Erding. (B)

14, SATURDAY MITTENWALD, AUSTRIA - INNSBRUCK,
GERMANY - ERDING

An excursion to Mittenwald and Innsbruck is planned. We'll first visit Mittenwald, a year-round resort in the Karwendel Range. After our stop here, travel over the border to Innsbruck, Austria, the capital of the Alps. During our walking tour in this charming old town, we will see the most characteristic landmark—the Golden Roof. After some free time, return to Germany. Our farewell dinner is planned at our hotel in Erding. (B, D)



15, SUNDAY RETURN
All too soon, our tour has come to an end. Following breakfast we'll transfer to the Munich Airport and check in for the return flights home. (B)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The cost of your tour includes:

Air transportation from Houston to Amsterdam and from Munich back to Houston with any regularly scheduled air carrier, based on a nonrefundable/nonchangeable fare, which requires a minimum of 10 passengers traveling roundtrip together. Tickets are issued 45 days prior to departure. **Passengers who cancel after tickets are issued will forfeit the total airfare in addition to the penalties noted under "Cancellation and Refunds."** If cancellation results from the documented hospitalization or death of the passenger, part of the airfare penalty will be waived.

Secure flight information. The requirement to collect date of birth, gender, and full name are federally mandated by the Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) Secure Flight Program. While disclosure of this information is voluntary, if it is not provided, participants may be denied boarding. TSA's privacy policy, as well as additional details, can be found at tsa.gov using the keywords Secure Flight. Witte Travel takes all reasonable steps to safeguard the privacy of this and any other information collected from its tour participants.

Land transportation. A deluxe air-conditioned motorcoach will be used for transfers, excursions, and travel between cities. Because many of Europe's old cities restrict the routes over which motorcoaches can travel, sightseeing within cities will often be done on foot and via public transportation.

Accommodations based on two persons sharing a room with private facilities. Most hotels we use range from moderate first-class to standard first-class. When hotels in these categories are not available, top-quality superior tourist-class properties are selected. **The supplement for single accommodations is \$375.** Single rooms in European hotels are often very small. If you register alone but prefer to share, we will do our best to assign a roommate. If a single room must be assigned to any member of the group for any reason, even if it is at the last minute or while on tour, we will need to charge the single supplement. Changes in rooming arrangements requested by the participant 45 or fewer days prior to departure may result in additional charges.

Buffet breakfast daily, lunches and dinners as indicated in the itinerary. Dinners do not include beverages.

A multi-lingual tour manager to accompany the group from arrival in Europe until departure from Europe. The tour manager will be assisted by local guides as needed.

Sightseeing and admission fees in accordance with the itinerary.

Porterage of one suitcase—with a maximum size of 62" (height plus width plus depth) and weight of 50 pounds—per person is provided at hotels to the greatest extent possible. Porterage is not provided at airports and some hotels do not have porters. You may also carry a purse, a camera, and one small piece of hand luggage weighing no more than 15 pounds and measuring 45" (height plus width plus depth). Soft-sided hand luggage is recommended. Wheeled hand luggage is acceptable. Please note that hand luggage does not fit in the overhead bins on the motorcoach. Depending on the size of the group, there may be room for hand luggage in the storage compartments under the motorcoach or by an empty seat inside the motorcoach. If there isn't room in the storage compartments or any empty seats, hand luggage will need to be placed on the floor in front of your feet. The size and weight restrictions noted for suitcases and hand luggage conform to most airlines' requirements and they are essential for everyone's comfort on board the motorcoach.

Tippling and taxes are included for all services, including the tip for the tour manager and motorcoach driver.

The tour cost does not include passports, airline luggage fees, optional travel protection plan including luggage and trip cancellation coverage, optional excursions, independent meals, and any other items not mentioned as included.

Optional travel protection. Witte Travel recommends that each traveler purchase a travel protection package. For your convenience, we make available a travel protection plan offered by Travelex Insurance Services. This travel protection can be purchased at any time prior to making the final payment for your tour. The policy exclusion for pre-existing conditions will be waived if your premium is received by Witte Travel within 14 days of the initial deposit for your tour, provided you are not disabled from travel at the time you pay your premium. Tours over 30 days are not eligible for coverage. The premium for the travel protection plan that applies to your tour is noted on the application form. It may be necessary to increase the travel protection premium for those participants who purchase additional services and/or upgrade their arrangements. The premium for the travel protection plan is non-refundable. The travel protection plan does not cover any travel arrangements not made by or purchased from Witte Travel.

Certain exclusions and limitations apply and are detailed in the Travel Insurance Certificate. For example, coverage does not apply to any sickness or condition of a Traveling Companion or an Immediate Family member traveling with you that existed during the 60 days prior to the effective date of the coverages (this exclusion is waived if your premium is received within 14 days of the initial deposit/payment for your Trip and you are not disabled from travel at the time your premium is received), suicide, normal pregnancy, war or any act of war, mental or nervous disorders. A Traveling Companion is defined as a person or persons with whom you have coordinated travel arrangements and intend to travel with during the Trip. Sickness or injury must commence while the travel protection plan is in effect for you. This plan does not cover a loss that results from an illness, disease or condition (of you, an Immediate Family Member, Traveling Companion or Business Partner), event or circumstance that occurs at a time when the plan is not in effect for you. A Travel Insurance Certificate, which fully details the coverages, provisions, limitations and exclusions of the insurance offered, will be included in the confirmation packet of those travelers who purchase this travel protection. For more information prior to purchase, go to wittetravel.com/group-travel/travel-protection/. You may also request a copy of the Certificate from our office at any time. This plan is administered by United States Fire Insurance Company, Eatontown, NJ.

Documentation: U.S. citizens are required to have a valid passport. If you already have a passport, check its expiration date now since most foreign countries require that passports be valid for at least three to six months beyond the traveler's intended return date. If your passport is due to expire shortly after your intended return, you will need to apply for a new one before departure. If you plan to visit countries other than those included in this tour on your own, contact Witte Travel & Tours for any special requirements. All non-U.S. citizens should contact Witte Travel & Tours for their special requirements. We will check the requirements for non-U.S. citizens both at the time they register for the tour and again approximately 45 days prior to departure. Witte Travel & Tours is not responsible for any changes in requirements for non-U.S. citizens that occur after our final check.

The tour cost is based on a group of 44 passengers, current tariffs for air and land arrangements, and on an exchange rate of \$1.40 to €1.00. The cost is subject to adjustment in the event of changes therein.

Reservations and payments. To make reservations on this tour, complete the Application Form and return it as indicated. Reservations cannot be accepted over the telephone. Payments are due as follows:

- Deposit of \$450 per person with Application Form by June 15, 2011. Reservations may be accepted after this date, provided space is still available.
- Payment of \$900 per person by October 1, 2011
- Payment of \$900 per person by December 1, 2011
- Payment of \$900 per person by February 1, 2012
- Balance due on receipt of final invoice sent approximately 30 to 45 days prior to departure

If you are registering for the tour after one of the above payment dates, increase your deposit amount accordingly so your account will be up to date. **Please note that checks returned due to insufficient funds are subject to a \$30 service fee.**

Credit card payments. Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express credit cards can be accepted for the deposit and/or scheduled payments, provided that the request to charge is indicated on the Application Form. The deposit charge will be processed shortly after receipt of your application. Subsequent payments will be charged in keeping with the payment schedule as outlined above.

Cancellations and refunds. Witte Travel & Tours must receive notice of cancellation in writing. Penalties are per person and will be based on the date of receipt, as follows:

The above penalties apply to the cost of the land arrangements and are in addition to the airfare penalty noted under "Air Transportation." The service fee noted under "Special Flight Arrangements," any nonrefundable portion of special arrangements made on behalf of the canceling participant and the cost of travel protection, if purchased, will also be added to the above penalties. Cancellation insurance is available. Please allow four to six weeks for processing of refunds. Refunds will be returned in the same form in which payments were received, i.e., payments made by check will be refunded via check to the person or organization that made the payments, and payments charged to a credit card will be refunded via a credit back to the same credit card.

Membership. Witte Travel & Tours reserves the right to accept or reject any person as a member of the tour and to expel from the tour any participant whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the tour group. Each special needs participant must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for his or her well-being. Witte Travel reserves the right to exclude from the tour any special needs person whose condition impairs customary operation of the tour.

Land-only participants. If you wish to make your own flight arrangements, contact Witte Travel for the land-only cost at least 90 days prior to departure. Participants who make their own flight arrangements are strongly encouraged to coordinate their flight schedules with the group's flight schedule and to use the same airports. The group's airport transfers on the arrival and return days will be timed to the group's flight schedule. Land-only participants may need to arrange for their own airport transfers. Contact Witte Travel for information and costs on options for private transfers. Witte Travel & Tours cannot be responsible for any inconveniences to land-only participants resulting from changes in the group's flight schedule. Participants who change their status to land-only less than 90 days prior to departure may be subject to penalties imposed by the airlines.

Domestic flight connections. Note on your application if you would like to fly to and from the international departure city. You will be contacted with schedule options and costs. **Witte Travel & Tours must receive requests for connecting flights at least 45 days prior to departure.**

Special flight arrangements. Note on your application if you would like to extend your stay in Europe and/or if you would like to depart from and/or return to another city. The number of passengers who can deviate from the group's flight schedule is restricted. You will be contacted to let you know if the arrangements you requested are possible and to advise you of schedule options and costs. Upon confirmation of your special flight arrangements, a non-refundable service fee of \$75 will be added to your account. **In the event of cancellation, the service fee and any nonrefundable portion of special air or land arrangements made on behalf of the canceling participant will be added to the penalties noted under "Cancellations and Refunds." Witte Travel & Tours must receive requests for special flight arrangements at least 45 days prior to departure.**

Special Meal Requirements. Please indicate on your application form if you need special meals such as vegetarian, diabetic, gluten-free, or low-sodium. Special meal requests cannot be guaranteed, but we will pass them on to the airlines and hotels. We will also inform your tour personnel, who will make every effort to see that your requests are met at the hotels. **Witte Travel & Tours must receive requests for special meals at least 45 days prior to departure.**

Time away from the tour. Advise Witte Travel & Tours in writing at least 45 days before departure if you plan to spend some time away from the tour. Wherever possible, you will be credited for missed hotel nights.

Final tour documents—including itinerary, hotel list, passenger list, flight schedules with departure instructions, and luggage tags—are sent about 10 days prior to departure. Flight tickets are usually made available at the airport at check-in time.

Responsibility. As the tour operator, Witte Travel & Tours will be responsible for supplying the services and accommodations outlined in the brochure as constituting the tour, except to the extent that such services cannot be supplied, wholly or partially, owing to circumstances beyond its control. In such cases, Witte Travel & Tours will use its best efforts to supply alternative services and accommodations, and no refunds will be granted provided that the alternatives are comparable to the original services and accommodations included in the tour cost. Witte Travel & Tours, its agents, sponsors, organizers and employees shall not be responsible for any injury, loss, damage, accident, delay, irregularity or expense arising from strikes, weather, sickness, acts of war or terrorism, governmental restrictions or regulations or from any act or omission on the part of any individual or company furnishing transportation, accommodations or any other services to the tour participants; nor shall Witte Travel & Tours be responsible for any injuries, death, damages, loss or delay in any means of transportation or by reason of any event beyond its actual control. Witte Travel & Tours reserves the right to make changes in the tour dates or itinerary routing should circumstances make such necessary. In case of insufficient participation, Witte Travel & Tours may cancel the tour. In the event of cancellation of the tour by Witte Travel & Tours, its liability will be limited to a refund in full of all monies paid by the participants. If available, Witte Travel & Tours will offer an alternative trip, which the participants may accept or reject.
